Travel information:

Arriving at Schiphol Airport you can take a direct train to Delft, dep. 17 or 47 after the hour, from platform 5-6. (38 min traveling time).

There are more trains (via Leiden Central or Den Haag HS) to Delft. (44 min traveling time). See for train schedule www.ns.nl, choose option 'English', for more information. From the railway station in Delft you can take a taxi to your hotel, or 8 minutes' walk. The hotel is situated in the centre. Travelling time from Schiphol Airport to Delft is about 50 minutes.

Train tickets can be purchased at the NS ticket offices at the railway stations. Tickets for the tram/bus/metro can be purchased in the tram/bus/metro. This is relative expensive, about € 3,00 for a short single trip. If you stay for a longer time and will make use of buses, trams and metro we advise you to buy at arrival a personal public transport card of € 9.10. You can upload this card. The ticket officer at the railway station can provide you with detail information.

Please pay close attention to your luggage. There could be pickpockets at the airport, in the train and on the platforms.
