

If you bring your own laptop with, the hotel has free wireless internet facilities. If you come by car you can park your car in one of the parking garages in the surroundings.

Travel information

Arriving at Schiphol Airport you can take direct train to Delft (€ 9,10). This train departs 17 and 47 after the hour from platform 5. Travelling time is 37 minutes.

Or you take a train to the direction Den Haag/The Hague (switch after 17 minutes at Leiden to a train direction Dordrecht). From Leiden CS to Delft CS will take 20 minutes. See for more information www.ns.nl, choose option 'English'. From the railway station in Delft you can take a taxi to your hotel, or 8 minutes walk. Enclosed you will find a map with the walking route. The hotel is situated in the centre. Travelling time from Schiphol Airport to Delft CS is about 45 minutes.

Train tickets can be purchased at the NS ticket offices at the railway stations. Tickets for the tram/bus/metro can be purchased in the tram/bus/metro. This is relative expensive, about € 3.00 for a short single trip. If you stay for a longer time and will make use of buses, trams and metro we advise you to buy at arrival a personal public transport card of € 7.50. You can upload this card. The ticket officer at the railway station can provide you with detail information.
